TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The main task of the volunteers will be organizing and implementing intercultural learning workshops for external partners (mainly schools) on topics related to intercultural education (intercultural communication, stereotypes and generalizations, etc) in cooperation with AFS volunteers. The workshops are based on non-formal education methods. They take place mainly in high schools, but sometimes they can also take place in middle schools and even elementary schools.

This comprises different tasks:

- Communication around the project and the team's activities
- Contact with volunteers and partner schools
- Organization and facilitation of the activities and follow-up tasks
- General administrative tasks
- Taking part and facilitate training sessions for volunteers

Expected Qualifications

- Experience and/or special interest in intercultural learning and active global citizenship education
- Be comfortable speaking in public and conducting virtual conferences
- Microsoft Office skills
- Enthusiastic personality and willingness to learn
- Previous long or short-term volunteer experience will be valued
- Good verbal and written knowledge of French appreciated
- Good knowledge of English appreciated
- Knowledge of and commitment to the mission and principles of AFS appreciated
